

House Bill 5003

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Budget and Management Division, Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by State Department of Agriculture.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Agriculture; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

(1) Fees for official field inspection of vegetable and specialty seed crops for seed producers are as follows:

- (a) Application fee for official inspection..... \$ 3
- (b) Per-acre field inspection fee \$ 6.50
- (c) Minimum inspection fee..... \$ 50
- (d) There is no maximum field inspection fee

(2) Fees for official seed sampling, inspection and verification services requested by owners or producers are as follows:

- (a) First sample..... \$ 36
- (b) Per-sample fee for up to three additional samples..... \$ 6
- (c) Minimum hourly charge \$ 48
- (d) Inspection fee for each occurrence when services are requested and seed lot is inaccessible..... \$ 50

(3) The fee for molecular analysis of seeds for regulated pests is \$140.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the fee adopted under ORS 607.300 for determining the adequacy of a fence, in an amount equal to the sum of the mileage to and from the site of the fence in question, at the state mileage charge, plus \$30 per hour for the time spent traveling to and from the site of the fence in question and for the time spent determining the adequacy of the fence in question, adopted

- 7 (a) Class 1 and Class 2 felines,

- 9 bears and Class 1 canines..... \$ 100
- 10 (b) Crocodilians..... \$ 75

11 (2) Fees for renewal of permits to keep exotic animals in captivity are as follows:

- 12 (a) Class 1 felines, Class 1
- 13 primates and bears \$ 100
- 14 (b) Crocodilians..... \$ 50

15 **SECTION 4.** This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
16 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
17 July 1, 2011.
